Statistics prove that if more people know CPR, and how to use an AED unit, then more lives could be saved. As a bystander, don't be afraid... Your actions can only help. Our church has 2 AED (automated external defibrillator) units and they are always ready to be used if the need arises. Please make yourself familiar with the location on the AED located in the hallway into Silver Hall by the water cooler and the AED located in front of the sanctuary on the right side. Our Staff, many ushers and members have been trained to do CPR and how to use the AED unit.
