Reformation Sunday, Today

During worship today, we will recognize our Scottish Heritage of the Presbyterian denomination known as "*The Kirkin' O' the Tartan*." As part of the celebration, Mike Harris, a member of the Lee County Pipes & Drums will share his artistry of bagpiping with the familiar tunes of Scotland the Brave and Amazing Grace.

The *Kirkin'O' the Tartan* is a celebration of Presbyterian roots, going back to the Scottish Reformation of the 16th century. At that time, the Scottish people expressed their family heritage by the wearing a specific plaid cloth known as a clan tartan. Following service, we will gather in Silver Hall for coffee hour to partake of

some traditional Scottish desserts.

On Sunday, November 3, during the 10:00 a.m. Worship Service, there will be a special tribute to Chapel by the Sea Members and Friends who have passed during the last twelve months (*November 2018 – November 2019*).

In early Christian tradition, saints' days began as a way to mark the anniversary of a martyr's death — his or her "birthday" as a saint. By the middle of the church's first millennium, there were so many martyrs (particularly due to the persecution of Diocletian) that it was hard to give them all their due. All Saints' Day was established as an opportunity to honor all the saints, known and unknown.

All Saints' Day has a rather different focus in the Reformed tradition. While we may give thanks for the lives of particular luminaries of ages past, the emphasis is on the ongoing sanctification of the *whole* people of God. Rather than putting saints on pedestals as holy people set apart in glory, we give glory to God for the ordinary, holy lives of the believers in this and every age. This is an appropriate time to give thanks to members of the community of faith who have died in the past year. We also pray that we may be counted among the company of the faithful in God's eternal realm. All Saints' Day has been celebrated on November 1 since the year 835. Previously it had been connected with the Easter season as a feast of all martyrs.
